

AWARDS/PRIZE MONEY

See Jumper prize money table for jumper distribution. Trophy or prize money and six ribbons in all classes unless USEF required. All prize money will be credited to the entry's account in the show office. Prize money in excess of balances due will be mailed to the designated payee and SS# or TIN on file unless otherwise directed within 30 days after the conclusion of the horse show. Each owner or payee must furnish the show office with an accurate and correct Social Security or Tax Identification Number before prize money will be deducted or checks issued. Entries not competing for prize money are exempt.

All class prize money will be distributed 30%-22%-15%-12%-11%-10% unless otherwise specified. If less than 10 entries in any class, surcharges may apply. Classes with \$1,000-\$2,500 in prize money need 10 entries to fill class and classes with over \$2,500 need 12 to fill, if not, 6 are needed to run class as a 100% entry fee sweepstakes. Prize money will be distributed 50%, 30%, 15%, 5%.
